CALL FOR ENTRIES



We are seeking films that provide a unique opportunity to experience the variety and vitality of later life. The Legacy Film Festival on Aging showcases films from around the world that celebrate older adulthood and deal with the challenges and triumphs of aging.

Entry Guidelines

- Film must portray people 55+ years of age and older.
- Both foreign and American short and feature-length narrative, documentary, experimental and animation films are welcome.
- Films must be in English, or have English subtitles that are clearly and boldly differentiated from the background.
- Films must be submitted for preview in online version (Vimeo link with password), or in *special cases*, DVD hard copy format. DVD entries must be labeled with title, name of artist, date of completion, and length.
- If chosen, final film must be sent by July 1, and be available for screening **September 2018**.
- Films should dispel stereotypes about aging and older adults, and educate viewers about aging in an entertaining and compelling manner.

- Intergenerational stories with one key subject 55 + years are welcomed.
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- Films may be eligible for future Legacy Film Series and distribution: see www.legacyfilmseries.com.

Note: Preview films in DVD format will not be returned unless accompanied by a self-addressed, postage-paid mailer with the title of the production clearly indicated on the mailer.

Entry Fees & Deadlines

- **EARLY:** Up to and by **March 31, 2018**
- **LATE:** April 30, 2018

- **Standard Entry** (equal to or longer than 30 minutes)
- **Short Entry** (less than 30 minutes)
- **Student Entry** (with copy of current student I.D.)

- **MID Standard Entry, April 1-April 29: \$40**
- **LATE Standard Entry: \$50**
- **EARLY Short or Student Entry: \$20**
- **MID Short or Student Entry, April 1 -April 29: \$30**
